



Name	Climate Change Science Initiative Final Report 2008-2012 (2012)
Description	The Climate Change Science Initiative (CCSI) was implemented as a pilot program by Fisheries and Oceans Canada, (DFO) acknowledging the importance of climate model development in predicting climate change's impacts on Canadian waters (both marine and fresh), as well as the value of models in understanding those impacts at the ecosystem level. It acknowledged that there are emerging issues related to climate change that have not been adequately researched, reflected in the three thematic areas under which projects were developed: climate change predictions and scenarios; ecosystem impacts and vulnerabilities; and emerging issues such as hypoxia and acidification
