



Name	Agricultural Adaptation Strategy for the Tantramar Region (2011)
Description	A study funded by the New Brunswick Regional Adaptation Collaborative (RAC) for the Sackville area examined flood risk areas and possible adaptation and mitigation options, including a section on agricultural production. Much of the agricultural land in the Tantramar region is in low-lying dyked land in the direct path of storm surges and sealevel rise. The report ncludes flood risk maps indicating agricultural land that would be affected by storm events, and additional map scenarios.
