<b>Description</b>	<p>From the website: The Climate Ready Estuaries funding will enable the Barnegat Bay Partnership and its key partners to initiate climate change vulnerability assessments and adaptation planning. The initial steps will include the following:</p> <p>Establishment of a Climate Change Workgroup within the Barnegat Bay Partnership's Science and Technical Advisory Committee; The convening of a series of public "listening sessions" during the winter and spring of 2010; and Co-sponsoring a technical workshop "Preparing your Community in the Face of a Changing Climate: Starting the Dialogue, which took place on April 1, 2010. Development of a Needs Assessment and next steps in order to develop a Climate Ready Adaptation Strategy.</p> <p>Ultimately, these activities will enable the Barnegat Bay Partnership to develop a climate change adaptation strategy which informs local municipalities and the public about regional challenges and their potential solutions.</p>
